- 21. <u>Did you know that stacked orders can be considered batch orders? Where if u cancel u only get half pay</u> for one order? Well I found out the hard way. Had a total wine and more order for \$20.50 supposed to get \$10.25 but only got \$5.12. Doordash is fucked
- 22. Delivery from Pizza Hut and I got a \$2 tip (\$9 total pay). Check the customer's receipt and there is a \$5.99 "delivery charge" that just goes straight to Pizza Hut...
- 23. <u>doordash gave me a triple order with PetSmart. in and out 3 items well the red card didn't work and</u> while support was helping me I had to unassign the two food orders in total I just lost 20 bucks and 10 points on my completion rate. They pretty much said too bad
- 24. made a total of \$5 in the last hour and a half
- 25. Ljust closed out an order and the Looking for Orders screen said \$0.00 dash total for the day so I rebooted the app and my dash was ended.

- 26. When all is said and done it really is the drivers who accept \$2.50-\$4 orders from no tippers that do the most damage to other drivers. If a driver doesn't pickup and order doordash must refund restaurant and order.
- 27. Delivery drivers confess to eating food, damaging packages and other bad behavior in poll
- 28. I had a conversation with another dasher who accepts every order... *emotional damage*
